PRESENTATION of WiLDAF/FeDDAF

WiLDAF/FeDDAF is a Pan African network bringing together 500 organisations and 1200 individuals with a view to promoting a culture for the exercise and respect of women's rights in Africa. WiLDAF/FeDDAF has the status of a non-profit making non governmental organisation.

The network was established at the regional conference held in Harare in Zimbabwe, in February 1990 and whose theme was "Women, right and development: network for empowerment in Africa".

Promoting mainly the effective utilisation by women in Africa of a variety of strategies including the law for the self-development of the community, the sub-region and the region.

Sub-regional offices enable the network to be closer to its members functioning in West, East and Southern Africa.

WiLDAF/FeDDAF IN WEST AFRICA

WiLDAF/FeDDAF is present in West Africa in 10 countries namely, Benin, Burkina Faso, Côte d'Ivoire, Guinea, Ghana, Mali, Nigeria, Liberia, Senegal, Togo and envisages to extend to Niger.

The WiLDAF/FeDDAF Office in West Africa has been opened since April 1997 in Lome, Togo.

1. Skills Training Workshops - 1999 & 2000

AGE in collaboration with Friedrich Ebert Foundation (FES) has undertaken two Skills Training Workshops for Assemblywomen in the Volta Region in August 1999 and again in October 2000

2. Mapping Exercise on Gender Activities

AGE in collaboration with DANIDA has undertaken a comprehensive research into the activities of women - Mapping Exercise on Gender Activities - in five regions in Ghana (Greater Accra, Upper East, Ashanti, Volta, and Central) from September 1999 to April 2000. The research provided information on NGOs, District Assemblies and CBOs in five regions for effective planning, implementation and monitoring of WID and Gender Activities

3. Dissemination Of Research Findings

It has also undertaken dissemination of the findings of the research to the stakeholders of the five regions (September-October 2000) with a view to updating the information collected and establishing a mechanism to mainstream gender at the district and regional levels

4. Skills Training Workshops for Prospective Women Parliamentarians -2000

Joint collaboration with FES, UNDP, CIDA and NIRP to conduct Skills Training Workshops for prospective women parliamentarians, September-October 2000.

5. Training of Trainers Workshop August, 2001

AGE in collaboration with the National Council of Catholic Women (NCCW) Organised a Training of Trainers workshop to equip the Diocesan Women Development Officers and other active female participants from each of the eighteen (18) dioceses nation-wide with practical skills in the following areas:

- ❖ Leadership skills
- ❖ Presentation and Communication skills
- ❖ Training Techniques and Methodologies
- ❖ Self-Empowerment and Assertiveness
- ❖ Advocacy and Lobbying Skills and
- ❖ Gender Issues and Analysis Skills

6. Training of Trainers Workshop - June, 2001

AGE in collaboration with United Women's Front obtained funding from Konrad Adenauer Foundation to organise a five day Training of Trainers workshop with the main theme "Enhancing the Participation of Rural Women in Public and Political Life." with the objectives stated below:

- ❖ To afford women the opportunity to understand the Local Government Structure, particularly the function of the District Assemblies within the decentralised policy
- ❖ To impart knowledge and skills regarding gender issues in local government and clarify its application in Local Government
- ❖ To impart skills in personal empowerment and develop strategies for women's participation in Local Governance

**7. Training for Women in District Level Development/ Strategy Development
November- December, 2001**

AGE in collaboration with ILGS under took three workshops. The main objective of the workshops was to provide an opportunity for participants from the 17 partner districts from the Volta and Upper West Regions of DSDA II to contribute to promoting gender sensitivity in the implementation of DSDA II activities Specifically the three- (3) workshops were to assist participants to:

- Acquire some critical personal effectiveness skills building /training for their role in local governance;
- Develop some skills in gender analysis and gender advocacy
- Develop a plan for formulating a draft basic district-specific gender strategy paper for the implementation of DSDA II activities; and
- Reflect on their own self-development strategies with respect to local governance

8. **Sensitization and Skills Training Workshop in Advocacy for Participation in Local Government and Training of Trainers for Christian Mothers Association**

January - April, 2002

AGE in collaboration with the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs (MOWAC), the Christian Mothers Association (CMA) and sponsored by the Konrad Adenauer Foundation (KAF) conducted Sensitisation and Skills Training programme respectively for women's participation in the June 2002 District Assembly elections.

The Ministry of Women and Children Affairs conducted workshops at Oda in the Eastern region, Joaso, Konongo in the Ashanti region and Sunyani in the Brong Ahafo region and Tarkwa in the Western region.

The Christian Mothers Association (CMA) conducted Training of Trainers workshops for their three (3) Provincial teams in Kumasi at the Christian Village, and Wa at St. Cecilia's Guest House and Ho at the Catholic Social Centre.

The workshops for the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs were preceded by rallies except in the case of Sunyani where the workshop ended with a rally.

The workshop attracted an average of thirty (30) participants made up of highly motivated aspirants, Assembly Members and women who will be trainers in their various communities and dioceses as in the case of the Christian Mothers Association.

9. **Skills Training For Registered Assembly Women Aspirants in Five Regions Eastern, Western, Central, Greater Accra and Volta Regions - July 2002**

The three broad main objectives of the workshop were:

- To afford women the opportunities to understand better the Local Government System particularly the functions of the district assembly.
- To impart skills that should improve their leadership and personal empowerment skills to enable them campaign effectively
- To ensure that they get elected.

10. **Data Collection Exercise On Female Contestants Of The District Assemblies August – November, 2002**

Advocates for Gender Equity (AGE) proceeded to conduct research in the 5 regions after the elections to compile a disaggregated data on women and men who got elected to the District Assemblies and more importantly, women who got elected to the Unit Committees.
